He was appointed CEO of Aflase Gold Limited (Aflase Gold) in April 2003. Aflase Gold, through a series of reverse take-overs, became Gold One in May 2009. Neal was primarily responsible for the creation of Uranium One Incorporated (Uranium One) from the Aflase Gold uranium assets. During this period, he was CEO of Aflase Gold and Uranium One until his resignation from Uranium One in February 2008. Prior to joining Aflase Gold, Neal held executive and senior management positions at Gold Fields of South Africa Limited, Harmony Gold and JCI Limited. He currently serves as non-executive director in a number of companies.
